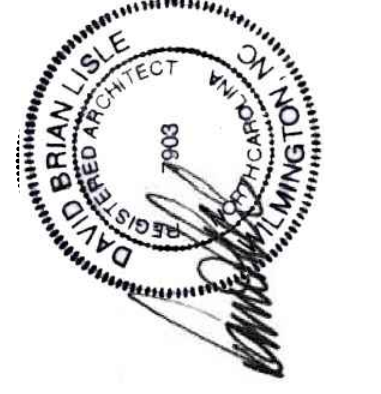
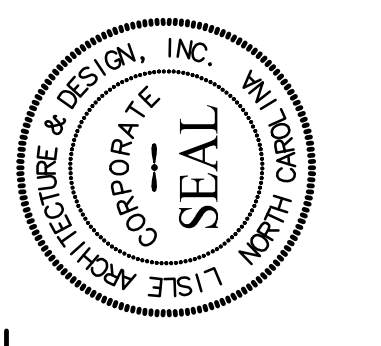


Shell Building Plan

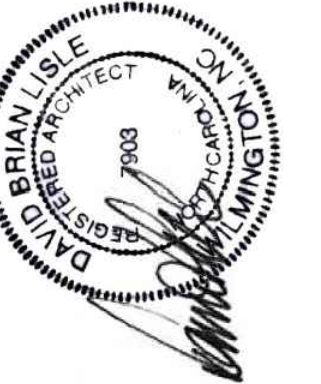
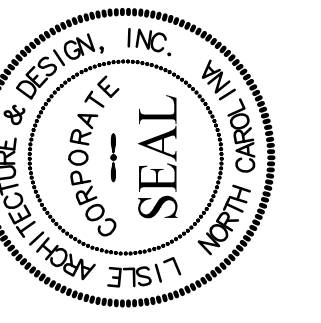


Elevation - North
